- 1) What principles or insights from Sunday's sermon did you find to be most helpful, most challenging, or most troubling? Why?
- 2) God told Adam that in the day he ate from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil he would die. Discuss the ways this came true after Adam and Eve rebelled against God's command.
- 3) After their rebellion, Adam and Eve tried to cover their sin with fig leaves and then tried to hide from God behind the trees of the garden. In what ways do we try to cover and hide our sin today? For example: religion, busyness, denial of sin, drinking, drugs, etc.
- 4) Read the following passages and discuss what they teach us about the human condition apart from Jesus Christ (Isaiah 53:6, Psalm 51:5, Romans 3:9-18, Romans 5:18-19, and Ephesians 2:1-3).
- 5) Considering the above scriptures, how would you answer someone if they asked you the following question: "Am I a sinner because I sin, or do I sin because I am a sinner?"
- 6) Read Luke 7:36-50 and discuss what we learn from this passage about those who acknowledge their sinful condition and those who refuse to do so.
