- 3) Before hearing Sunday morning's sermon, how would you have responded to the statement "God has entrusted me with a divinely empowered special ability that is vital in what God wants to accomplish in the world today?" Would you have agreed or disagreed? Why?
- 4) Read Acts 1:4-8.
  - a) Why did Jesus have his disciples wait for the baptism of the Holy Spirit?
  - b) Why do you think Jesus redirect the disciples' focus on the second coming to receiving the baptism of the Holy Spirit?
  - c) According to verse 8, what is the ultimate evidence of receiving the baptism of the Holy Spirit?
  - d) What ought to be the result of God entrusting us with this power?
- 5) According to Acts 17:6 what was the result of the Church being baptized with the Holy Spirit? Do feel God would like to do this with our church?
- 6) Look up the spiritual gifts listed in Romans 12:6-8, 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, and Ephesians 4:10. Do you recognize any of these gifts functioning in your life? If so, what gift(s) has God given you and how have you been able to use it/them to build up the body of Christ?
