- 1)** What principles or insights from Sunday's sermon did you find to be most helpful, most challenging, or most troubling? Why?
- 2)** Genesis 2:18-20 records Adam naming the animals. Share with the group which animal you think would have most amused Adam.
- 3)** Discuss the concept that God may have created Adam with unlearned intelligence.
- 4)** Discuss Genesis 2:20 in light of Genesis 1:27's declaration that God made Adam in His own image.
- 5)** Verses 2:18 & 20 introduce the concept of Eve being Adam's helper. The same Hebrew word used in these verses for "helper" appears in Exodus 18:4 and Psalm 121:1-2. After reading these verses, would you conclude that God created Eve to be Adam's subordinate helper or co-equal partner?
- 6)** Genesis chapters 1 and 2 establish the truth that being an image bearer of the glory of God is the highest ideal of what it is to be human. Today, human flourishing and pleasure have replaced God's design for what it is to be human, especially in the realm of human sexuality. Discuss how Christians can best be salt and light in this time of cultural darkness?
