- 1) What principles or insights from Sunday's sermon did you find to be...

- 4) The parable of the Talents is a parable about how we live our lives between the first and second coming of Christ. Read Matthew 25:19 and 24:22-24 and discuss what these verses teach us about our use of time and Christ's second coming?
- 5) What do Isaiah 40:3-8 and James 1:9-11 teach us about the passage of time?
- 6) Read Matthew the parable of the Sower from Matthew 13:3-9. Pay special attention to the thorny soil and the explanation Jesus gives concerning it in Matthew 13:22. What do we learn from the thorny soil concerning the use of our time and fruitfulness in God's Kingdom?
- 7) If, as they say, time is money, how much time would you spend to hear the invaluable words "Well done thou good and faithful servant?" (Matthew 25:21&23).
