- **1.** Thinking back to Sunday's sermon, is there anything that particularly caught your attention, confused or challenged you?
- **2.** Discuss something new that you have discovered as you have contemplated the concept of becoming a Christ-centered, Acts 1:8 Family.

#### A CHRIST-CENTERED

We start with Jesus— He is the One who is the source of our love, the cause of our worship and the core of our message

### **ACTS 1:8**

We rely on the Holy Spirit's filling as we seek to fulfill our calling to every segment of society

#### **FAMILY**

We are at our best when we do this together—Serving in a local church and among a community of local churches.

**3.** Which of the following four ways we seek to express ourselves as a Christ-centered, Acts 1:8 family most resonates with your soul?

Together we will Love, Proclaim, Reach and Launch.

- **4.** Pastor Kurt used John 3:16 as his basis for the fact that God is a speaking God who has revealed Himself to us. Discuss how we find God revealing himself to us in the following areas.
  - **a.** On the lighter side<sup>©</sup> Have a contest of who can speak John 3:16 both the fastest and most accurately and then discuss how God reveals Himself to us in humor.
  - **b.** How does God speak to us through general revelation, that is His creation (see Romans 1:20, Psalm 8 & 19:1).
  - **c.** How does God speak to us through specific revelation, that is His word, the Bible.
  - d. Discuss the following statement;

- e. According to the words of Jesus as recorded in John 14:7-9, what is the most accurate revelation of God?
- Read the follow verses that teach the concept of the Bible as the inerant and inspired word of God and discuss how the Bible is a trustworthy witness of God's will for His creation.

## 2 Timothy 3:16-17

<sup>16</sup> All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; <sup>17</sup> so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

### 2 Peter 1:20-21

<sup>20</sup> But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, <sup>21</sup> for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

- **6.** Discuss Pastor Kurt's assertion that because God is a proclaiming God, we as His people ought to be a proclaiming people.
  - **a.** How does Jesus' command that we are to be His witnesses (see Acts 1:8) add to this conversation?
- **7.** Discuss the apparent dichotomy presented in the following quote, often but dubiously, attributted to St. Francis Assisi;

# Preach the Gospel always and if necessary use words.

- **8.** Read Romans 10:14-15 and discuss the vital place that sharing God's word verbally has in the process of salvation.
- **9.** What does the phrase "show and tell" add to this discussion.
- **10.** Discuss how the following statement by John Stumbo might help us be better witnesses of God's love;

## **Enter & Bless**

"This is one of the most simple, yet significant, principles I could give you.

Enter into each moment and leave it better."

- **11.** If time permits, have two voluteers role play a scenario of sharing both the gospel and an invitation to accept Christ as savior.
