

- 1) What principles or insights from Sunday's sermon did you find to be most helpful, most challenging, or most troubling? Why?
- **2)** Share with the group which of the Bible's many precious and magnificent promises mean the most to you and why.
- **3)** Verse 3:1 introduces the serpent's first words, "Indeed has God said..." Satan used these words to weaken Eve's trust in God's word. Do you ever find yourself saying this same thing about the reliability of God's word? If so, in what area and why?
- **4)** Compare God's actual words in Genesis 2:16 & 17 with how Eve states them in Genesis 3:2 & 3. Does Eve add to, subtract from, or soften God's word?
 - **a.** How do you think Eve's alteration of God's word affected her ability to withstand Satan's temptation?
- **5)** Compare the three areas in which Satan tempted Eve as recorded Genesis 3:6 with the three ways he tempted Jesus as recorded in Luke 4:1-13.
- **6)** What does 1 Corinthians 10:13 tell us about our ability to overcome the temptations of the Devil, this fallen world, and our own sinful desires?
- **7)** Read Hebrews 4:14-16 and discuss what these verses tell us about Christ and His understanding of the human condition.
